What is Pancreatic Cancer?

With an overall survival rate of just 8% over five years, pancreatic cancer has no early detection tests, no effective long-term treatments and, unless the cancer is surgically removed in its earliest stages, no cure. More than 53,000 Americans will be diagnosed with pancreatic cancer this year alone. The disease affects men and women equally, almost always after the age of 45. It is the second most common malignant tumor of the gastrointestinal tract and the third leading cause of cancer-related deaths in adults. Increased awareness, education and early detection are our most powerful weapons in the fight against pancreatic cancer.



Village Cup Commodore's Message

The Port Jefferson Yacht Club's Village Cup Regatta was founded in 2010 to give the membership of the Port Jefferson Yacht Club (formerly The Setauket Yacht Club), and the surrounding area a way to make a significant contribution in the fight against Pancreatic Cancer and to help those in our community with the greatest need for humane, end of life care. There is little in the way of early detection, prevention or effective treatment for Pancreatic Cancer. The five year survival rate of just 8% has been little changed over the last 40 years. This devastating disease is currently the number three cause of cancer deaths in the United States and it is expected to become number two, after lung cancer, within the next decade.

The Village Cup Regatta is a friendly sailboat race hosted by the Port Jefferson Yacht Club in which a team with members from Mather Hospital competes against a team from the Village of Port Jefferson. In just the past six years, this event has raised over \$300,000 with the proceeds split evenly between The Lustgarten Foundation, to advance the scientific and medical research related to the diagnosis, treatment, cure and prevention of pancreatic cancer, and Mather Hospital's Palliative Medicine program. These two outstanding beneficiaries of the funds raised use 100% of the proceeds for either research or care of individuals. This is a fantastic way to have a direct positive impact on the people who benefit from these two programs.

The Port Jefferson Yacht Club's Village Cup Regatta has been recognized across Long Island and beyond by being awarded the Long Island Business News' Health Care Hero Award and the Nassau-Suffolk Hospital Council's Theodore Roosevelt Award. In addition, this event has been covered by Cablevision's Channel Twelve News, FiOS TV, Newsday, The Port Record/Village Times, Main Sheet Magazine and many other boating publications.

At the Port Jefferson Yacht Club we have lost a number of cherished members to this terrible illness and we are committed to doing something about it. Please join us to defeat this deadly disease and to help those with comprehensive, compassionate care in their time of greatest need.
