


Diagram of proposed dock changes and expansion. See next Page for some explanation...



I would also like to explain how this all started. We knew we were restrained by our existing license from expanding but we saw Danford's was able to expand. At this years commissioning I happened to find myself sitting at the same table as Jonathan Kornreich our Councilman and I asked him how to start the process of adding additional underwater land to our lease. His response was you start with me and to send him the information. I had existing surveys and sent it out with a description of what I would like. This information was forwarded to Barbara Wiplush, Asst. Town Attorney and then forwarded on to the Town appraiser. He asked for a current survey with the additional land marked as proposed Parcel D. Since we had already approved an as built survey, I had the surveyors add this new information to the survey. It is now in the hands of the Town appraiser and the Law Department. Without the additional land we could do a modest slip increase off the East dock, but it will be a patch job and in my opinion not in our long term best interests of the club and only yield eight additional slips.


