• BE SAFE!

- Wear a properly fitted USCG life jacket at all times when on, in or near the water.
- Wear appropriate closed-toe shoes at all times.
- Remain within the sight and sound of my instructors and never go anywhere alone or without permission.
- Follow all instructions given by the PJYC Instructors and Staff. Never throw rocks or sand or engage in horseplay of any kind.
- Never jump off boats or docks.
- Never go swimming without the permission of my Instructor. • Report any injury or accident, no matter how minor, immediately to my Instructor.

• BE RESPECTFUL!

- Take good care of equipment, marine life, and the natural environment.
- Cooperate, be a good team player, and help keep it positive and fun.
- Keep it neat and clean- put all garbage and recycling where it belongs.
- Never use glass bottles or jars.
- Respect myself and peers I will not bully, tease, use foul and/or inappropriate language, and will keep my hands and feet to myself.

• HAVE FUN AND LEARN!

- Participate in all activities.
- Have a positive attitude.
- Leave all unnecessary items including electronic devices and valuables at home.

As a Parent of a participant in the PJYC Sailing Program, I WILL:

- Provide *complete* and *accurate* registration information, expressly emergency contact information and medical information.
- Review and sign the Code of Conduct with each participant I am responsible for.
