What is Pancreatic Cancer?

With an overall survival rate of just 8% over five years, pancreatic cancer has no early detection tests, no effective long-term treatments and, unless the cancer is surgically removed in its earliest stages, no cure. More than 55,000 Americans will be diagnosed with pancreatic cancer this year alone. The disease affects men and women equally, almost always after the age of 45. It is the second most common malignant tumor of the gastrointestinal tract and the fourth leading cause of cancer-related deaths in adults. Increased awareness, education and early detection are our most powerful weapons in the fight against pancreatic cancer.
