What is Pancreatic Cancer?

With an overall survival rate of just 9% over five years, pancreatic cancer has no early detection tests, no effective long-term treatments and, unless the cancer is surgically removed in its earliest stages, no cure. More than 56,000 Americans will be diagnosed with pancreatic cancer this year alone. The disease affects men and women equally, almost always after the age of 45. It is the second most common malignant tumor of the gastrointestinal tract and the fourth leading cause of cancer-related deaths in adults. Increased awareness, education and early detection are our most powerful weapons in the fight against pancreatic cancer.

Primarily the Palliative Medicine team at Mather Hospital helps patients and their families who are contending with a life changing diagnosis. The team works with the patient and family to navigate the complex decision making about all aspects of the patient's care. In concert with the patient's physician, Mather's Palliative Medicine team educates the patient and family to their disease process, and will address psychological, cultural and/or spiritual issues the patient or family may be struggling with. Village Cup Commodore's Message

The Port Jefferson Yacht Club (formerly Setauket Yacht Club), will be celebrating sixty-two years of boating through the waters of this beautiful harbor. This also marks the twelve-year anniversary of the Village Cup. Two wonderful milestones for sure. However, this year also marks the first time in the sixty-two-year history of the club that a father and son will have both held the position of Commodore. My father William C. Hausner was the Commodore in 1986. I could never have imaged that I would have been given this opportunity to follow in his “wake”, but I write this message today with great pride and reverence. I also write this with a heavy heart since my dad is no longer with us. As many of you know Bill Hausner was taken from his family and friends in 2007. Pancreatic Cancer was the cause. This event is very dear to our family. On a happier note, if you knew my dad this is the best type of venue. A regatta! My father was all about racing and I thank him for providing me with the deep love of sailing. I also want to thank the founders of this event that started it back in 2010. You have created a different type of fundraiser.

Last year’s pandemic challenges required the event to be scaled back to keep everyone safe. It still raised forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) bringing the total to date since 2009 to six hundred and forty-two thousand dollars (\$642,000). That sum has been equally split between the Lustgarten Foundation and Mather Hospital. Thanks to everyone that has had a hand in helping reach these heights – but we are not done!

The Lustgarten Foundation was created to fund Pancreatic Cancer Research and is committed to bringing this long-ignored disease to the forefront of cancer research. Lustgarten continues to be the worlds largest private supporter of that research. Some of that work is being done right here on Long Island at the Cold Spring Harbor Laboratory.

John T. Mather Memorial Hospital, just up the hill from the harbor, opened on December 29, 1929 with 54 beds. Now known as Mather Hospital, part of the Northwell Healthcare Network, it houses the Palliative Medicine Program. This unit helps patients and their families who are contending with life changing diagnosis by helping them navigate the complex decisions and providing the support needed at those times.
