Dock & Mooring Rules for Members and Guests

As of: January 17, 2022

The following rules apply to PJYC Members, guests, and transients visiting us:

- LIABILITY: Dock & Mooring use is at your own risk. PJYC is not responsible
 for theft, damages, loss, or destruction. The user assumes all liability and
 responsibility for any personal injury, loss of life, or damage to property,
 passengers, guests, damage by the docks/finger piers, electric, spectators
 or employees of the dock users.
- Transients: See the Dockwa reservation for other requirements such as check-in/check-out times etc...
- No signage:
 - No For Sale signs are allowed.
 - No political flags, signage, or banners are allowed.
- No Fires/Barbecues: No barbecues or open fires are allowed on the dock or boat at any time. The club provides grills which are free to use under the awning near the docks.
- Quiet Time: For the consideration of other dock users, quiet hours are to be observed between 10 pm to 7 am.
- Nothing may be attached to pilings, docks and finger piers except lines and fenders.
- No Swimming: No swimming off the dock allowed due to risk from moving vessels and the potential of electricity in the water. There is a public beach next to the club which can be used.
- Courtesy: Be courteous to all staff, members, and other guests while on the property.
- Security: All club facilities are under 24x7 video surveillance for security purposes only.
