What is Pancreatic Cancer?

With an overall survival rate of just 11% over five years, pancreatic cancer has no early detection tests, no effective long-term treatments and, unless the cancer is surgically removed in its earliest stages, no cure. More than 60,000 Americans will be diagnosed with pancreatic cancer this year alone. The disease affects men and women equally, almost always after the age of 45. It is the second most common malignant tumor of the gastrointestinal tract and the third leading cause of cancer-related deaths in adults. Increased awareness, education, early detection, and new treatments are our most powerful weapons in the fight against pancreatic cancer.

Village Cup Commodore's Message

This is the Port Jefferson Yacht Club's 13th annual Village Cup Regatta. The Regatta pits teams from the Village of Port Jefferson and Mather Hospital in a friendly competition with additional crews and boats supplied and captained by members of the Club. Over the years, bragging rights have traded hands several times with last year's trophy going to the Village of Port Jefferson. It's a wonderful opportunity for our members to interact with the community giving them a chance to experience the thrill of sailboat racing while raising money to help fight a dreadful disease, pancreatic cancer. Over the past 13 years, the Regatta has raised \$750,000 which has been divided between the Lustgarten Foundation and Mather Hospital's Palliative Care Center.

While pancreatic cancer is the third leading cause of cancer death in the United States, up until relatively recently very little funding went to the research of this deadly disease. The Lustgarten Foundation is the world's largest private funder of research into the treatment and cure for pancreatic cancer. At the time of its founding, less than one half of one percent of federal cancer research funding went to the study of pancreatic cancer. Since then, the Lustgarten Foundation has helped to raise over \$225 million for research.

The Mather Palliative Care Center, serves to help people deal with a life-changing medical diagnosis by improving their quality of life and helping to relieve stress. The center offers patients and their families the support and care they need while dealing with the diagnosis and treatment of serious illness.

Many families have been touched by this terrible disease including members of the Port Jefferson Yacht Club. In fact, the club has lost two Commodores to pancreatic cancer. It is estimated that nearly 50,000 lives in the U.S. will be lost to pancreatic cancer this year, more mothers and fathers taken too soon. Please join us in the fight against pancreatic cancer and to help support those suffering from this and other serious diseases. Your donation can help to make a difference.
