About Pancreatic Cancer

With an overall survival rate of just 13% over five years, pancreatic cancer has no early detection tests, no effective long-term treatments and, unless the cancer is surgically removed in its earliest stages, no cure. More than 66,000 Americans will be diagnosed with pancreatic cancer this year alone. The disease affects slightly more men than women, almost always after the age of 45. It is the second most common malignant tumor of the gastrointestinal tract and the third leading cause of cancer-related deaths in adults. Increased awareness, education, early detection, and new treatments are our most powerful weapons in the fight against pancreatic cancer.

Palliative Care at Mather Hospital

The Palliative Medicine team at Mather Hospital helps patients and their families who are contending with a life-changing diagnosis. The team works with the patient and family to navigate the complex decision making about all aspects of the patient's care. Effective palliative care maximizes quality of life while respecting the patient's wishes. In concert with the patient's physician, Mather's Palliative Medicine team educates the patient and family to their disease process, and will address psychological, cultural and/or spiritual issues the patient or family may be struggling with. Then, after lunch onboard provided by the skippers, we head out to our race area where we have a friendly race between the "Mather Team" and the "Village Team".

Then back to the Village Center for the Skipper's Reception with food, auctions, and a chinese auction of dozens of items donated by local businesses and individuals.
